Annual Administrative Report (2014)

Mokokchung College of Teacher Education (MCTE) Yimyu-Mokokchung, Nagaland was originally founded in 2011 as Mokokchung B.Ed College and start the first Academic Session in 2012 by the Government of Nagaland as the 2nd Govt. College of Teacher Education. The teacher trainees from Mokokchung, Longleng, Zunheboto, Mon and Tuensang Districts can come to gain quality Teacher Education.

Today the college can be considered as a fast growing Teacher Training Institute in a short span of three years. We strive for excellence in all we do and able to do so because of an incredible teaching faculty, staff and dedicated teacher trainees, which continues to give themselves in so many ways. The college could provide personalized training for the students, provide them quality guidance that noticeable shift in their teaching ability. The extensive educational care, leadership programme and academic expectation make the college a viable choice for anyone looking for a well-balanced teacher education.

I. Academic:

The rules and regulation for B.Ed, with regards to admission, qualification of teachers, transaction of curriculum, working days etc. are all followed according to Nagaland University norms, National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE) norms and standard as well as directives received from Higher Education, Govt. of Nagaland.

Intake Capacity:

The intake capacity of the college is 100 candidates for every academic session. However the college could not get requisite number of candidates (deputationists) from School Education Department. In 2014 only 74 (seventy four) candidates registered for B.Ed. programme.

Course of Study:

1 (one) year duration, which break up into 2 (two) Semesters. 1st Semester starts from January to June in which the courses are more of theoretical in nature. 3 (three) core papers and 2 (two) optional papers to be selected by the teacher trainees i.e., Methodology of Teaching 1) Maths 2) Biological Science 3) Physical Science 4) English and 5) Social Sciences..

2nd Semester starts from July to December. In the 2nd Semester there are 2 (two) theory papers and more of practical oriented courses such as 1) Micro Teaching 2) Block Teaching 3) Practice Teaching in the real classroom. (the trainees are to cover minimum 10 (ten) Practicing Schools 4) Community Works 5) Work Experience 6) Club Activities, etc.

Admission:

Admission for 2014 B.Ed. start from 15th Jan 2014 to 25th Jan 2014. Altogether 74 (seventy four) trainees admitted. Pre-service teachers=35 and In-service teachers=39. Out of 74 candidates, there were 48 (forty eight) female and 26 (twenty six) male candidates.

Regular classes start on 1st Feb '14 with a regular Acting Principal, 4 (four) teaching faculty and 3 (three) visiting lecturers, one librarian with 14 non-teaching staff. Transaction of the courses for 1st Semester as well as 2nd Semester could be made with the support of visiting lecturers and supervisors for practical works. The college (MCTE-Yimyu-Mokokchung) highly indebted to the most sincere and dedicated visiting lecturers and supervisors from DIET, N.U. Scholars, Senior officers (School Education Dept.) Mokokchung.

They are infact the pioneer as they joined the college in the year of its establishment (2012). They work tirelessly even to the extent of going beyond the call of normal duty in order not to compromise the quality of teacher education deserves appreciation.

IV. Other Achievements apart from the above mentioned heads.

Yes MCTE, Yimyu-Mokokchung Nagaland have the chance to generate some opportunities such as tree plantation.

MCTE staff and students planted 100 saplings of palm (süra) trees, and also planted other saplings like mango, guava, coconut, litchi, banana, etc, which were collected from Horticulture farm at Green Park, Dimapur; planted more than 100 saplings of evergreen plants as well as flowering plants in and around the college campus.

In 2014, the college (MCTE) could developed a syllabus for vocational course of study in collaboration with Horticulture Dept. of Nagaland which awaits the approval from Nagaland University and sanction comes from RUSA project. The college will introduce Horticulture as a vocational course of study, where the teacher trainees can gain the basic idea of modern technology in the field of horticulture which is different from our traditional method.
