1. INTRODUCTION OF THE COLLEGE



Mokokchung College of Teacher Education, is the second Government College in the state established in 2012. After a long gap of 37 years, Government felt the need of establishing more training colleges to cater to the needs of the people in general and to the teaching community in secondary and higher secondary level in particular. The college strives to prepare teachers to be competent human facilitators of teaching by enhancing qualitative improvement of education in the state. The college is affiliated to Nagaland University and recognized by National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi. It offers full-length regular B.Ed course of 2 (two) years, based on the UGC B.Ed syllabus.

The college (MCTE) start B.Ed Degree programme of 1 (one) year from 2012 to 2014 and introduced 2 (two) years B.Ed programme from 2015. The college cover a vast geographical part of the state, covering five districts namely- 1) Mokokchung 2) Zunheboto 3) Mon 4) Longleng 5) Tuensang.

2. ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT DURING 2016

Mokokchung College of Teacher Education is affiliated to Nagaland University and recognized by the National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi. It offers full-time regular B.Ed course of 2 (two) years with 4 (four) semesters based on the UGC B.Ed syllabus. The academic session starts from 1st July each year. The college works 6 (six) days a week with Saturdays engaged for club activities, guest lecturers, seminars and other co-curricular programmes. 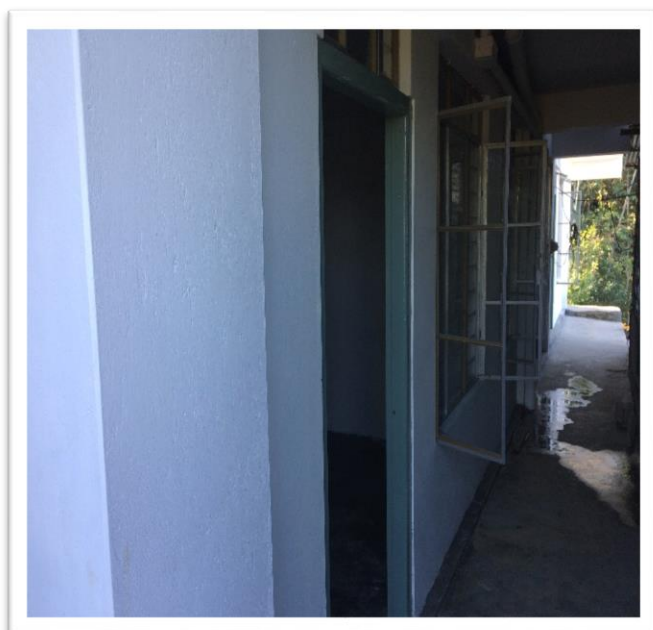
