The Mokokchung College of Teacher Education, was established by the Government of Nagaland (Department of Higher Education) at Yimyu, Mokokchung, on 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb 2012. Having initially been run out of the District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Yimyu, the permanent Administrative Building was inaugurated on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2014. The building is currently used for both Administrative and Academic purposes, being the only building in place.

The College seeks to ensure professional competency and facilitate the continuous development of committed and humane secondary and higher secondary teachers (in-service and pre-service) from the districts of Mokokchung, Longleng, Zunheboto, Mon and Tuensang.
