The Mokokchung College of Teacher Education, is the second Secondary Teacher Education Institution established by the Government of Nagaland (Department of Higher Education) on 22nd Feb 2012. The College is located at Yimyu, Mokokchung, in a campus area of 5 acres. The Administrative building, inaugurated in 2014, is presently being used for both Administrative and Academic purposes.

The College is temporarily affiliated (Provisional) to Nagaland University and process of acquiring Permanent Affiliation is underway. It is recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi. It offers full-time regular B.Ed course of 2 (two) years with 4 (four) semesters. The academic session starts from 1st July each year.
