Established on 22nd Feb 2012 by the Government of Nagaland (Department of Higher Education) Mokokchung College of Teacher Education, is the second Secondary Teacher Education Institution in the state. The College is located at Yimyu, Mokokchung, in a campus area of 5 acres. The Administrative building, inaugurated in 2014, is presently being used for both Administrative and Academic purposes. The construction of the Academic Building has been sanctioned during the Financial Year 2020-21.

The College is temporarily affiliated (Provisional) to Nagaland University and process of acquiring Permanent Affiliation is underway. It is recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi. It offers full-time regular B.Ed course of 2 (two) years

comprising of 4 (four) semesters. The academic session starts from 1st July each year. However, due to the ongoing Pandemic, the New Session for the new batch for the year 2020 began in October 2020 only.
