Mokokchung College of Teacher Education (MCTE) was established on 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb 2012 by the Government of Nagaland (Department of Higher Education), and is the second Secondary Teacher Education Institution in the State. The College is located at Yimyu, Mokokchung, in a campus area of 5 acres. The Administrative building, inaugurated in 2014, is presently being used for both Administrative and Academic purposes. The Academic Building was sanctioned during the Financial Year 2020-21 and the construction is ongoing.

The College has been recognized under 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 since March 2021. The College is temporarily affiliated (Provisional) to Nagaland University and process of acquiring Permanent Affiliation is underway. Recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi, it offers full-time regular B.Ed course of 2 (two) years, comprising of 4 (four) semesters.
